

# Everdoor™ Vinyl Garage Door Warranty

## NON-PRORATED PROTECTION

Everdoor™ vinyl garage door sections are warranted by the Premium Garage Door Company to the Original Purchaser/Property Owner from Date of Installation for so long as the Original Purchaser/Property Owner shall live and own the property, against manufacturing defects in material and workmanship that result in cracking, corroding, peeling, flaking, rusting or de-lamination of the exterior surface of the door panel and abnormal weathering and discoloration, under conditions of normal use and service and subject to the terms and conditions of this Limited Warranty.

In the event that the garage door is purchased by an entity other than a living person such as a corporation, a commercial or retail application, condominiums, apartments or property with multiple owners the warranty period shall be for ten (10) years from the original date of installation, under this Limited Warranty.

Any claims of defects under this Limited Warranty must be made to Premium Garage Door Division, P.O. Box 67, Mt. Hope, Ohio 44660, Attn: Garage Door Customer Service, within the warranty period and promptly after discovery of the claimed defect, describing the defect claimed, together with the proof of purchase. A reasonable time should be allowed for inspection purposes. If, after inspection, the Manufacturer determines that the claim is in accordance with the terms of this Limited Warranty, then the Manufacturer agrees as its option to repair or replace the section or part of the product. Labor, installation and any similar costs are excluded herein and shall not be paid by the Manufacturer.

The Manufacturer does not warrant installation nor defects caused by installation. This Limited Warranty is void if any of the following occurs: (a) Improper installation techniques; (b) Abuse, misuse, neglect or improper storage; (c) Alteration by reason of applied heat, swelling, solvents, chemicals or any other alterations beyond the Manufacturer's control; (d) Fire, flood, hurricane, tornado or other storm or casualty, or other Acts of God; (e) Adverse effect of air pollution and normal weathering of surfaces; (f) Use in commercial applications.

The Manufacturer of this product does not recommend or approve this product for all possible end use application. Your local Code Authority should be consulted as to its safety and applicability for intended use.

The Limited Warranty shall be for the benefit of the Original Purchaser/Property Owner only and shall not be transferable.

## **WARNING: DO NOT PAINT THIS PRODUCT. Painting this product will void Warranty.**

The Warranty statements contained in this Limited Warranty set forth only the express warranties extended by the Manufacturer for the garage doors, in lieu of all other warranties, and the provisions of this Warranty shall constitute the entire liability of the manufacturer and the property owner's exclusive remedy for breach of this Warranty. Any implied warranties imposed by law, such as the implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, are limited in time to the express duration of this Limited Warranty. Wayne-Dalton shall not be liable to the property owner for incidental or consequential damages for breach of any express or implied warranty on the garage door.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts and some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you. This Warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

## THE CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF VINYL GARAGE DOORS

Like any other exterior surface, Everdoor™ garage door sections will have dirt exposure from atmospheric conditions. Ordinarily, the cleaning action of rainfall will be adequate to wash the door, or the door can be washed periodically by hosing with a garden hose and clear water (in particular) for the areas not accessible to rain. If you desire to do a more thorough cleaning, or where soil collection conditions occur, follow these simple instructions.\*

1. Use a soft-bristled, long-handled washing brush. It attaches to your garden hose and makes washing your door easier. Do not rub vigorously which may create glossy areas over the vinyl finish.
2. For hard-to-remove dirt, such as soot and grime found in industrial areas, wipe the garage door down with a solution consisting of the following ingredients:
  - 1/3 cup powdered detergent (Tide or equivalent)
  - 2/3 cup household cleaner (Spic & Span or equivalent)
  - 1 gallon water
3. If mildew is a problem in your area, prepare the solution above but substitute 1 quart of liquid laundry bleach for 1 quart of water.
4. Start at the bottom and work up to the top, as less streaking will result. Immediately following all washing operations, thoroughly rinse the surface area with fresh water from a garden hose.

Do not use cleansers containing abrasive particles, solvent or ammonia-type cleaners or paint remover for cleaning the vinyl door. When using any of the above chemical cleaning agents, observe the chemical manufacturer's recommended safety precautions. Protect against contact of the solutions with eyes or skin.
